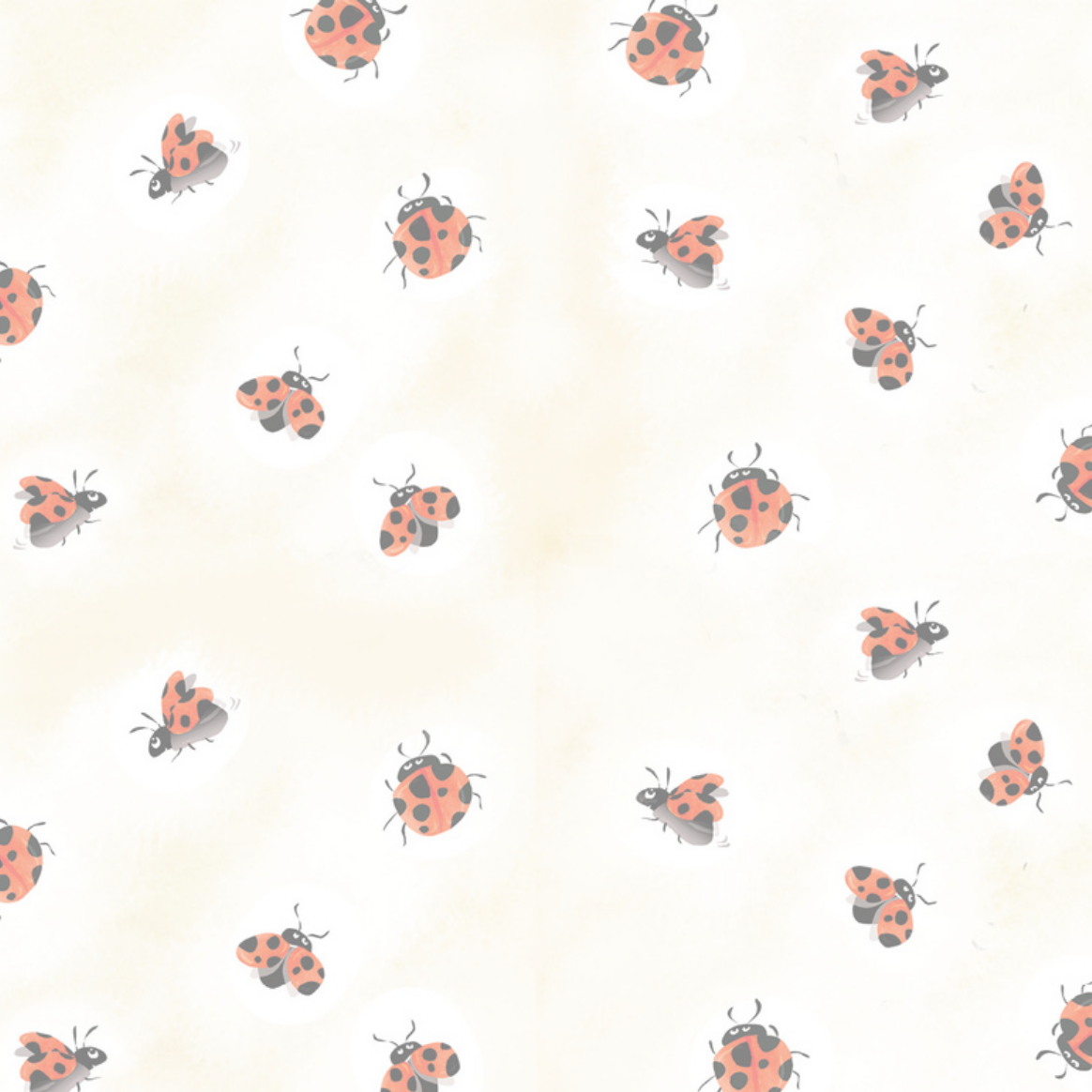
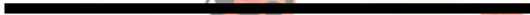

some fruits!



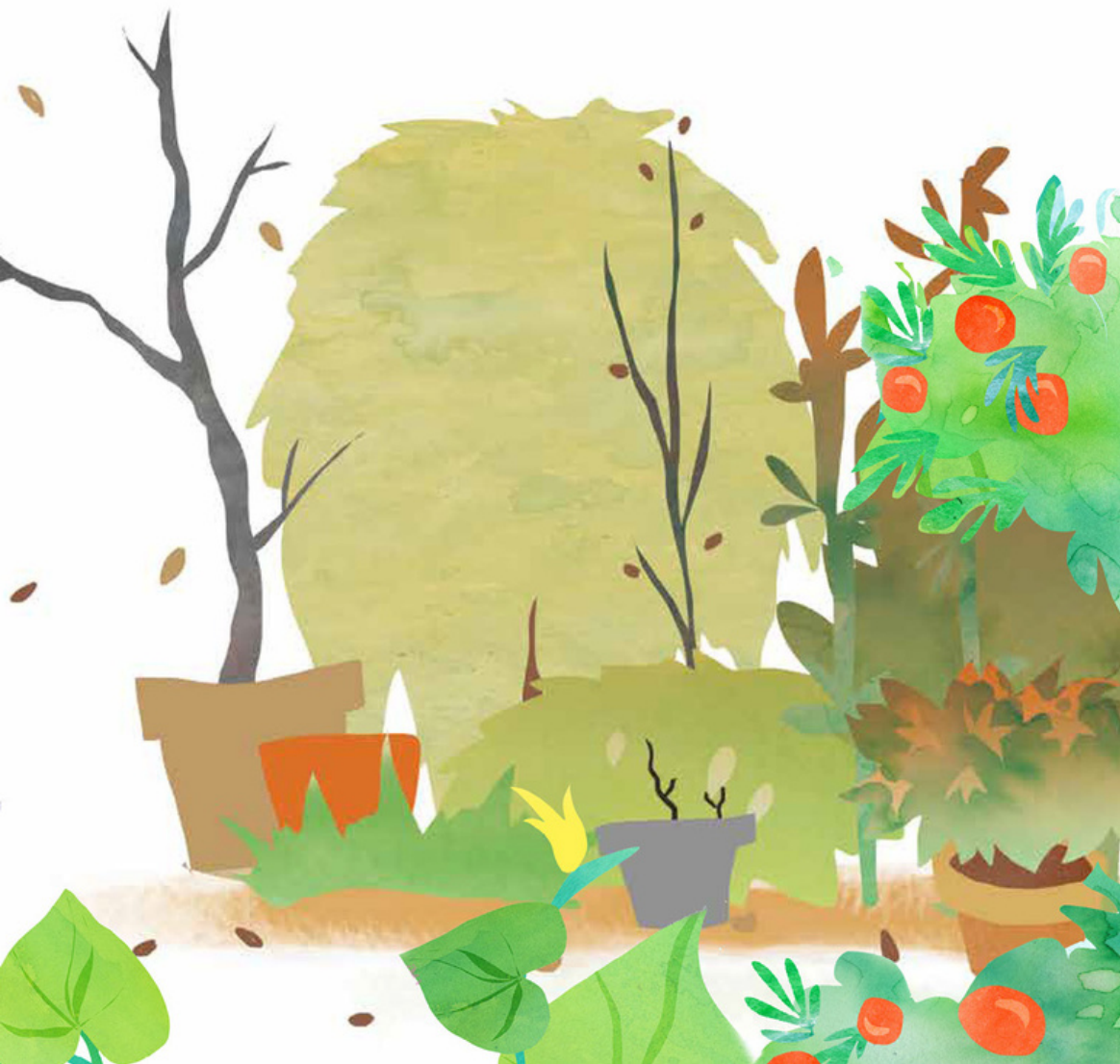
But one day, Grandpa looks glum

The ladybirds started eating the pests. After a while, the garden blossomed again!


