



# WHO TOOK MY SHOES?

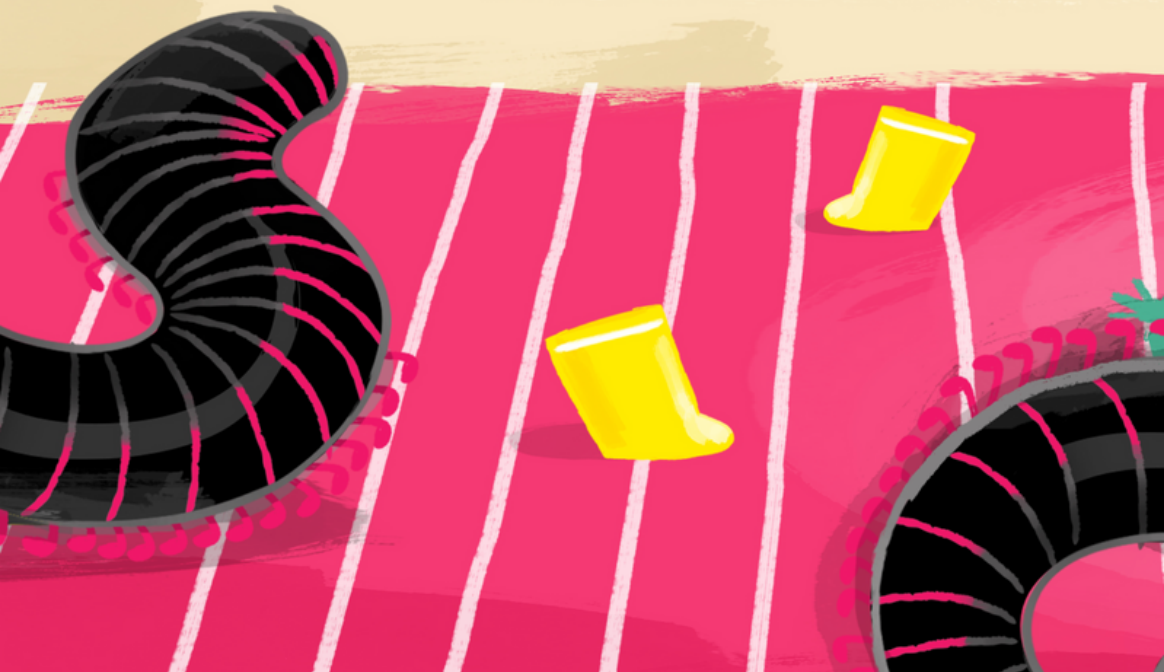




**THIS BOOK BELONGS TO**

Flamingo," said Baby Frog.**

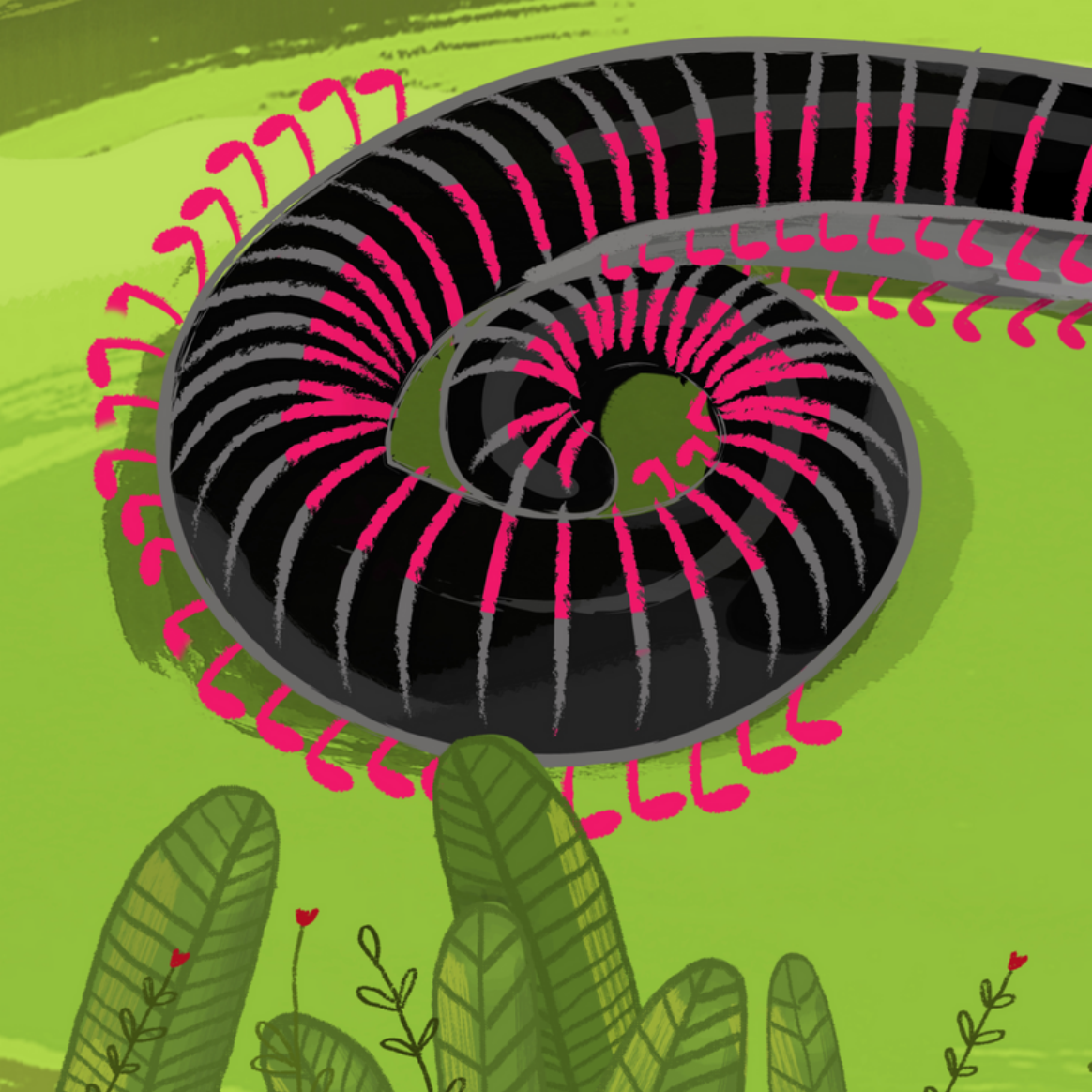






**Little Millipede asked Miss
