



Tiny Tim is walking down the street. when a button bounced his way.




"I wonder where this button is from," Tiny Tim started walking down the busy street.








"It is scary out here!" said Tiny Tim to himself.



Tiny Tim saw a green man. "Is this yours?" asked Tiny Tim.




But the green man did not say anything. He just turned red.




Tiny Tim continued to walk down the street.

"What is this?" wondered Tiny Tim.




"WHOA!"

"I am all wet!" said Tiny Tim.




"I think the button came from the other side of the road," said Tiny Tim, after drying himself.




SPLASH!

"Has anyone lost a button?" shouted Tiny Tim.





"Yes, it is mine! Thank you for bringing it back," said Dorothy the Doll.
